

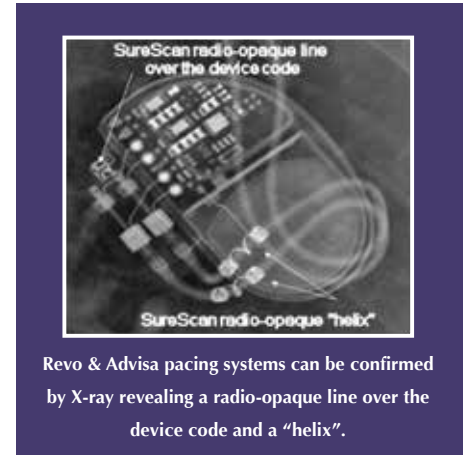
# Wake Radiology FDA Approves Pacing System for MRI

## REVO™ & Advisa™ MRI SureScan Pacing® Systems are FDA approved for MRI

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) recently approved the first cardiac pacing system that allows patients to undergo an MRI procedure when specified MRI conditions for use are followed. The Medtronic Revo & Advisa MRI SureScan Pacing Systems were specifically developed for use with MRI.



As you are probably aware, previous cardiac pacemakers were contraindicated for use with MRI, but now patients with a complete Revo & Advisa MRI SureScan Pacing Systems (consisting of the Revo & Advisa MRI SureScan IPG and two CapSureFix MRI SureScan leads) can undergo an MRI.

- ♥ Please verify the device and leads on your patient's pacemaker identification card. If the card isn't available, a chest X-ray can also confirm if a pacemaker is Revo or Advisa. If it doesn't have SureScan Technology, then it's not FDA-approved for an MRI examination.
